

DOT Project Update

In these unprecedented times of the COVID-19 pandemic, the DWM Board and management has decided to pause the Dulverton Organics Transformation (DOT) project.

This decision is in response to the current, necessary travel restrictions and operational changes made by the various businesses involved in tendering for the project's design. These changes make it difficult for contractors to prepare tender submissions with the required level of certainty, and risk disrupting our business's usual tender assessment process.

We will continue to monitor the situation to determine the appropriate time to re-start the facility upgrade project so that it delivers the best outcome for our local councils and communities, as originally intended.

The existing Dulverton landfill and organic composting facility continues to operate, including use of the upgraded windrow turning machine.
